



# Accessible Community Housing in The Galilee

**PROJECT COST: 247,500**

**Who You Will Help**  
Kav Lachayim currently serves and cares for children aged 6-21 who suffer from severe disabilities. The services offered in the home are now going to be expanded beyond 21 years old to support adult members of the community from all backgrounds. In order to do this, JNF will be assisting with funding the construction of two housing units that will allow for communal living. There, adults residents with muscular dystrophy, brain damage and other complex disabilities will receive the care they require in order to live as independently as possible

**Your Donation Will Fund**  
The project includes a complex of two adjacent houses, where 20 residents can live full time along with caregivers. Two 1/4 acre plots of land have been set aside in Kibbutz Hagoshrim. Each house has two floors and will include additional space for administrative work. The design of the space will be safe, aesthetic, and accessible – accommodating the needs of the residents and encouraging daily interactions with the community.
