\ Cabin Renovations - 7 Needed

To reach (and accommodate) larger groups of students, the Center needs to expand its capacity with new cabins as well as renovations on existing cabins. Renovations fund the installation of solar power systems, cooling system, new painting, a fire prevention system, ceramics, internet connection and furniture.

Cost per Cabin: \$7,700

\ New Cabin Builds - 4 Needed

To reach (and accommodate) larger groups of students, the Center needs to expand its capacity with new cabins as well as renovations on existing cabins. Building new cabins includes all foundational building elements, installation of solar power systems, cooling system, painting, a fire prevention system, ceramics,

Cost per Cabin: \$22,000

\ Accessible Cabin - 1 Needed

Renovations will improve accessibility and comfort in the cabins: installing larger bathroom and entrance doors, safer flooring and roofing, installation of solar power systems, cooling system, painting, a fire prevention system, ceramics, internet connection and furniture.

Cost per Cabin: \$24,200
